




Justice Advocacy Groups

- Try to solve the underlying (core) reasons for crime
- Improve the fairness of the justice system
- Help those who break the law return to their communities



What Else Do Justice Advocacy Groups Do?




 Arrange conferences between victims and offenders



What Else Do Justice Advocacy Groups Do?






 Provide education about law and the justice system
