

Types of Retribution



Rehabilitation


• Consequence intended to <u>reform</u> (change) a convict so that they can lead productive, crime free lives







Types of Rehabilitation



Community Service

- Work given back to the community. Ex.
 - Food bank
 - Paint over Graffiti
- Connect offender with community affected by crime



Counselling / Health Program

- Support / treat issues with offender
- Examples:
 - Drug / Alcohol Programs
 - Counselling for difficult life situation



Conferencing

- Offender meets the person they harmed
- See the consequences of their actions
- Allow offender <u>and</u> victim to heal from crime



Retribution

- Punishment given to someone in retaliation for a criminal act
- **Deter** (scare) offender so crime will not happen again
- Deter others so crime will not happen at all



Types of Retribution




Restitution

Criminal Record





- Permanent record about crime
- Affects chances for:
 - Jobs
 - Traveling
 - Housing

Prison

• Separate offender from society
